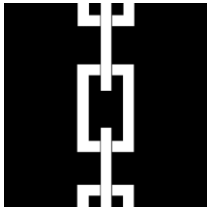


## Waste Sorting and Recycling Instructions



### Metal

*Examples: Ratchets, chains and end fitting components.*

Separate the metal from anything that is not metal on the product.

The metal is sorted in metal recycling.



### Cardboard

*Examples: Cardboard box, cardboard lid, cardboard cover, and cardboard paper.*

Cardboard boxes can often be reused. If this is not the case, they are folded and flattened, smaller boxes are placed in larger ones to save space. Then they are sorted in paper recycling.



### Plastic

*Examples: Edge protection, stretch film, air cushions and PP strapping.*

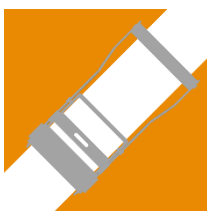
Plastic items such as the examples above are put in plastic recycling. If there are other substances that are not plastic in the product, these are removed before the plastic is sorted in the plastic recycling.



### Combustible

*Examples: Polyester straps and yarn.*

Items that cannot be recycled in any other way than through energy recovery are sorted in combustibles.



### Lashings

*Examples: Long part, short part, and complete.*

Lashings consist of three possible components: metal, polyester straps, and plastic. Cut off the polyester from the tensioners and end fittings. The end fittings and tensioners are put in metal recycling. Tensioners can have plastic handles, in this case remove the plastic and sort it in the plastic recycling.



### Rubber

*Examples: Friction mats, and wheel chocks.*

These articles made of rubber must be recycled in the same way as tyres. When the wheel chock or friction mat is worn out and no longer fulfils the function they previously had, they must be recycled.
